## "HINDU MUST GO," IS SLOGAN OF NEW UNION

Everett, Aug. 17.--At the close of a mass meeting of mill workers addressed by State Organizer Young, of the American Federation of Labor, at the labor temple last night, called for the purpose of explaining to the workers "How to eliminate Hindu labor from Everett," a mill workers' union was organized with 450 charter members.

The leaders asser[Sic] that by Labor Day they will have 1500 members and will carry banners reading, "Mill men, take your choice between the Hindu and the white man," and "The Hindu must go." They will then send a committee to the owners demanding the discharge of the Hindus or to suffer the consequences.
