

HERNAN SINGH WILL FIGHT DEPORTATION

Writ of Habeas Corpus Was Issued This Afternoon by Justice Macdonald.

Hernan Singh, the Hindu whose discharge and subsequent rearrest(Sic), caused such a commotion at the courthouse a week ago, is to be brought up on habeas corpus again tomorrow before Mr. Justice Macdonald, when efforts will be made to have him discharged from the custody of the immigration officers on the ground that the present charge is res judicata of the charge on which he was recently released and that the man can not(Sic) be tried twice for the same offence.

Mr. A. H. MacNeill, K. C., will rely on the judgment of Mr. Justice Morrison on the Rahim case.

"Can you not proceed by summons. These friends of yours are taking up a great deal of the time of the courts nowadays," queried Justice Macdonald.

"I am afraid not. We are informed that it is the intention of the authorities to deport this man on the boat which sails tomorrow, and the application is therefore urgent," said Mr. MacNeill.

"Their desire to stay in the country is certainly very flattering and it is their right to use the courts," commented his lordship.

"It is their only chance. They have to do this: it is their only remedy," added Mr. MacNeill.

His lordship accordingly gave special leave to bring the matter on tomorrow morning.
