Our campuses are located on the unceded traditional territory of the Stó:lō peoples. We express our gratitude and respect for the honour of living and working in S'ólh Téméxw (Our Land).

UFV supports Indigenous learners and continually seeks to incorporate Indigenous ways of knowing.

UFV's coat of arms includes symbols of Stó:lō Indigenous culture, local wildlife, and elements of the Fraser Valley landscape. The featured motto, "IYAQAWTXW," is in the Halq'eméylem language of the Stó:lō and means "house of transformation," reflecting UFV's mandate as a place of change — of intellectual and character transformation.

The Mission campus at Heritage Park Centre offers a selection of academic courses and is home to our Graphic and Digital Design program.


**HOPE**








**CHANDIGARH**

# STEP 1. CHOOSE YOUR PROGRAM

UFV offers 17 bachelor's degrees, three master's degrees, and more than 100 certificate, diploma, and post-degree programs.

If you study full-time, a bachelor's degree usually takes four years, a diploma two, and a certificate one. Many of the courses taken as part of one- or two-year programs will count toward a higher credential. ## GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

# PAYING FOR YOUR EDUCATION

## FINANCIAL AID AND AWARDS

Every year, millions of dollars in federal and provincial loans, grants, bursaries, scholarships, and awards are processed and disbursed to UFV students through UFV’s Financial Aid and Awards office.

If you’re enrolling at UFV in the academic year immediately following your high school graduation, you may qualify for a UFV entrance scholarship. Recipients are selected based on academic excellence, community and school involvement, volunteer experience, and leadership activities. The application deadline is March 1 (September 1 for Trades programs).
